
Best of the Best

Dental implants use strong, biocompatible titanium to create artificial tooth roots. Because the jawbone is a living structure, the implant stimulates the bone to continue carrying nutrients and provide a stable foundation for a single implant that supports a crown or for multiple implants that support a full set of tooth restorations.

It's a multilevel, detail-demanding process, but the key to affordability, Dr. Kosinski notes, is having an office equipped with leading-edge technology and staffed by the most efficient, proficient personnel.

“For example, high-tech dental CT scanning allows us to create a three-dimensional image of the patient's mouth,” he explains. “We can perform a virtual surgery first, thus increasing accuracy and reducing the time needed to place the implants. We use the best materials available, CAD/CAM-designed restorations, and U.S.-based labs that meet our high standards.
